

DECISION No. 12
of 9.01.2004
on the authorisation of the State aid specific allocation to
SC “Sema Parc” SA Bucuresti as part of the State aid scheme contained by
art. 7 of GO no. 65/2001 on the establishment and functioning of Industrial
Parks

The Competition Council’s Plenum,

Based on:

- 1.** Decree no. 1075/2001 on the appointment of the members of the Competition Council;
- 2.** The provisions of the Competition Law no. 21/1996, published in the Official Gazette no. 88, Part I, of 30.04.1996, with subsequent amendments and completions;
- 3.** The provisions of the Law no. 143/1999 on state aid, published in the Official Gazette no. 370, Part I, of 03.08.1999, with subsequent amendments and completions;
- 4.** The Regulation regarding the organization, functioning and procedure of the Competition Council, published in the Official Gazette no. 50 bis, Part I of 25.03.1997 with subsequent amendments;
- 5.** The Regulation on the form, content and other details of the state aid notification, published in Official Gazette no.125, Part I of 24.03.2000;
- 6.** The Regulation on regional state aid and the State aid for SMEs (hereinafter the Regulation), published in the Official Gazette, Part I, no. 470/02.07.2002;
- 7.** The notification of the intention to grant the State aid, submitted by the Ministry of Administration and Interiors under Note no. 13449/SG of 10.11.2003, registered at the Competition Council as no. RS-AS 65/11.11.2003. The notification became effective as on 12.12.2003;
- 8.** The Note of the Department for State aid Authorisation concerning the notified state aid.

Based on the following:

- 1.** According to the provisions of art. 12 of GO no. 65/2001 on the establishment and functioning of Industrial Parks and of the Law no. 490/2002

for the approval of GO m. 65/2001 on the establishment and functioning of Industrial Parks, the industrial parks established on their basis benefited from the facilities provided by art. 7 of this Ordinance.

2. The State aid notified by the Ministry of Administration and Interiors represents a State aid specific allocation within the existing State aid scheme represented by art. 7 of GO no. 65/2001, with subsequent amendments.

3. The beneficiary of the notified State aid is SC “Sema Parc” SA, which is the administrator of the Industrial Park “Euroland Semanatoarea”.

4. The State aid is granted in relation with the initial investment aimed at overcoming some regional disadvantages for ensuring the development of the area Bucharest-Ilfov. The Industrial Park is established in the view of capitalizing the material and human potential within the area in which is being established. By the State aid granting it will be incentive the achievement of the infrastructure necessary to the Industrial Park aiming at increasing the number of jobs and the foreign investments.

5. The establishment of this Industrial Park will contribute substantially to the local development, both of Bucharest and of its adjacent area, by an economic concentration and important businesses. Developing certain economic activities in an area, capitalizing material and human resources do not distort the competitive environment but contribute to its incentive.

6. The notified State aid is related to the initial investment, consisting of the creation of the basic infrastructure regarding the necessary and opportune utilities: electric power, gas, water, sewerage, telecommunication, provided to companies interested in creation of adequate production spaces and services. The total value of the investments is of ROL 142,254,000,000, equivalent to Euro 3,500,000 (exchange rate used is of ROL 40,644 for 1 Euro); thus, there are met all the conditions provided under art. 2 and art. 5 of the Regulation for the State aid to be considered regional State aid for initial investment.

7. The investments carried out for establishing the Industrial Park “Euroland Semanatoarea” shall be maintained during the existence of the park, namely 30 years, being thus observed the condition to maintain the respective investment for a minimum period of 5 years, provided under art. 11 of the Regulation.

8. The estimated total value of the eligible costs for the investments to be carried out is of ROL 124,614,504,000 while the estimated value of the State aid is of ROL 7,112,700,000. Following the calculation it results an intensity of 5.7%. As a consequence, it the observed the art. 9 of the Regulation on regional state aid and State aid for SMEs, which states that the gross intensity of the regional State aid for large companies must not exceed 50%.

9. The investment Program will be carried out in percentage of 84.6%, with the beneficiary's contribution, being thus observed the provision of art.8 of the Regulation on regional state aid and State aid for SMEs, stipulating that the beneficiary's contribution destined to finance the investments must be at least 25%.

10. The data presented in the notification submitted to the Competition Council lead to the conclusion that the State aid specific allocation to be granted to SC "Sema Parc" SA does not affect significantly the normal competitive environment and does not breach the correct application of the international treaties to which Romania is party.

11. Under art. 13 (1) of the Law no. 143/1999 on state aid, the Competition Council shall permanently survey all existing aids. If it will be noticed that this State aid scheme or the State aid specific allocation significantly distort the normal competitive environment and the application of the international agreements to which Romania is party, the Competition Council shall request the state aid grantor to take the appropriate measures to eliminate its incompatibility with the Law no. 143/1999 on state aids.

DECIDES

Art.1. Within the meaning of art. 12 par. 2 let. b) read in conjunction with art. 14 par. 1 let. f) of the Law no. 143/1999 on State aid, the Competition Council authorizes the State aid to be granted to SC "Sema Parc" SA Bucuresti as State aid for regional development.

Art.2. The estimated value of the State aid to be granted is of ROL 7,112,700,000.

Art.3. The present Decision becomes effective at the date of its communication.

Art.4. The present Decision shall be communicated by the Secretariat General of the Competition Council to the Ministry of Administration and Interiors.

Art.5. According to the provisions of art. 29 of the Law no. 143/1999 on State aid, the present Decision can be appealed within 30 days as of its communication by concerned persons before the Bucharest Court of Appeal, Division Contentious Administrative.

Art.6. The Secretariat General and the Directorate for State Aid Authorization of the Competition Council shall pursue the fulfillment of the present Decision.
